These criteria can be used when you are creating your 5-paragraph essays...

Graphics – Are they good? Are they overly simple? Could they be better?

Usefulness – Was the app helpful/useful?

Ease of use – How easy was it to use the app? Too easy? Too complicated?

Usability – Did the app work? Were there any glitches? Could the glitches be worked around? Did the app crash at all?

Purpose – What is the purpose of the app? What is it supposed to do?

Target Audience – Who is the manufacturer/programmer intending to use this app? Young/old? Male/female? Anyone at all?

Creator – Who created/developed the app? A company? A company you heard of? An individual?

Truth in advertising – Did the app live up to its claims in the description? Did it do what it said it would do?

Educational use - Are there any teachers to whom you could suggest this app for classroom use?

Comparison – Are there other apps or computer programs that you can compare this app to?

Recommendation - Would you recommend this app to others? Anyone, or only certain people?
